OBJECTIVE

Any country's future is heavily influenced by the caliber of its people. It assumes enormous importance for the development of young people into self-assured leaders with the necessary personal qualities and character traits, so they may take their place as responsible citizens of the nation. In addition to academics, young people must be exposed to activities that foster the growth of their personalities and character, which will help them become effective leaders.

AIM:

- ✓ To instill the values of selfless service, adventure, comradeship, discipline, leadership, and a secular worldview in to our young students.
- ✓ To develop a human resource of motivated, well-organized youngsters.
- To provide a conducive climate to encourage young people to pursue careers in the military, air, and sea forces.
- ✓ To provide leadership in all spheres of life and to be constantly accessible for the service of the country.

ORGANIZATION

The NCC is headed by a Director General with the rank of Lieutenant General. He is assisted by two Additional Director Generals (A and B) of two-star rank (Major-General, Rear-Admiral or Air Vice-Marshal). Five Brigadier level officers and other civil officials also assist him. The Headquarters is located in Delhi. There are 17 Directorates, located in the state capitals headed by an officer of the rank of a Major General from the three Services. Depending upon the size of the state and growth of NCC in the states, Directorates have up to 14 Group Headquarters under them through which they exercise their command and control of the organization in the state. Each group is headed by an officer of the rank of Brigadier or equivalent known as Group Commander. Each NCC Group Headquarters control 5-7 units (BNs) commanded by Colonel/Lt. Col or equivalent. Each Battalion consists of companies which are commanded by the Associate NCC Officer (ANO) of the rank of Lieutenant to Major. In all there are 95 Group Headquarters in the country who exercise control over a network of 667

Army Wing Units (including technical and girls unit), 60 Naval Wing Units and 61 Air Squadrons. There are two training establishments namely Officers Training School, Kamptee (Nagpur, Maharashtra) and Women Officers Training School, Gwalior.

TIME of SELECTION : July/August month of every year.

ENROLMENT of STUDENTS as NCC CADETS:

- 1. Eligibility Conditions Citizen of India.
 - Bearing good moral character.
 - Enrolled in an educational institution.
 - Meets the prescribed medical standards.
 - Age Senior Division/Wing (Boys/Girls) 15 to 23 years.
 - Enrolment Period Senior Division/Wing (Boys/Girls) 3 years.
 - 2. Physical examination: This is first step of selection procedure. It includes run, chin-up, sit-up etc.
 - 3. Written test and Interview.
 - 4. Application for Enrolment.
 - 5. A student desirous of being enrolled in the Senior Division shall apply to the ANO/ Officer Commanding of the nearest NCC Unit.
 - 6. Medical Examination.

DOCUMENTATION:

- 1. 10th and 12th class mark sheet.
- 2. Blood group certificate.
- 3. Aadhar Card photocopy.
- 4. Cadet/Guardian's Bank account details photocopy.
- 5. College admission fee receipt.
- 6. 04 Passport size photo civil uniforms.

TRAINING PERIOD:

Total training period for SD and SW is 3 years with an extension of 1 year permissible on exceptional condition. Every cadet has to undergo service training for a period of at least 4 hours per week during the training year. However, no training is carried out during periods when

the college or school through which a cadet is enrolled is closed for a vacation. Every cadet has undergone service training for a minimum period of 75% of total hours during the annual college. Every cadet, who has completed one full year of training and is in his (second year), attends an annual training camp of 9–10 days to fulfil the eligibility for certificate exam.

CERTIFICATES and EXAMINATION

- ✓ There are 3 Certificates in NCC. Below describes about it from lower value to higher value:-
- ✓ Certificate A (at school level): It can be written by JD/ JW cadets of NCC, cadets of class 8 & 9. After passing those classes, it can't be obtained.
- ✓ Certificate B: It can be written by SD / SW cadets of NCC, cadets after class 10 or those studying for +3 (degree). In the second year of training they can appear for the same.
- ✓ Certificate C: It is the most important certificate for NCC cadet. Now it can be written in the 3rd year of training, in the 3rd year of degree course/those having 'B' certificate, can write it in the first year after his +2 and in the 1st year of degree by SD / SW cadets only.
- ✓ These certificates are awarded as grading of (1) 'A' grade, (2) 'B' grade, (3) 'C' grade.

Army attachment camps are conducted by the NCC in collaboration with Indian army as the cadets are attached to the specific regiments. Under this camp, cadets are trained in military tactics including day/night warfare and also get familiar with weaponry. These are some specially organized camps by NCC to promote leadership qualities. This also aims at developing officers like qualities and exhorts the inherent personality of cadets.



We used to travel to several locations in Jaipur on certain days, including the visit to the 61st Cavalry in Jaipur, the Indian Army's only cavalry regiment, which has about 300 horses. Tree Plantation Drive by NCC Cadets in the Colleges and schools


